## Environmental Protection Act 1990 – Section 46

### Anti-social behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 – Public Space Protection Order

This is a formal notice issued by North West Leicestershire District Council requiring you as the occupier of premises to follow the conditions set out below. Failure to follow these instructions could result in enforcement action being taken.

- Please make sure your recycling and waste containers are put out by 6am on your collection day (or after noon on the day before collection is due)
- Once emptied, the bins, recycling containers and recycling bags should be returned to your property as soon as possible and in any case before noon on the day after collection
- Only waste contained within the correct containers will be taken (other than cardboard flattened to 2ft x 2ft). No extra waste should be put out unless arranged before with the council.
