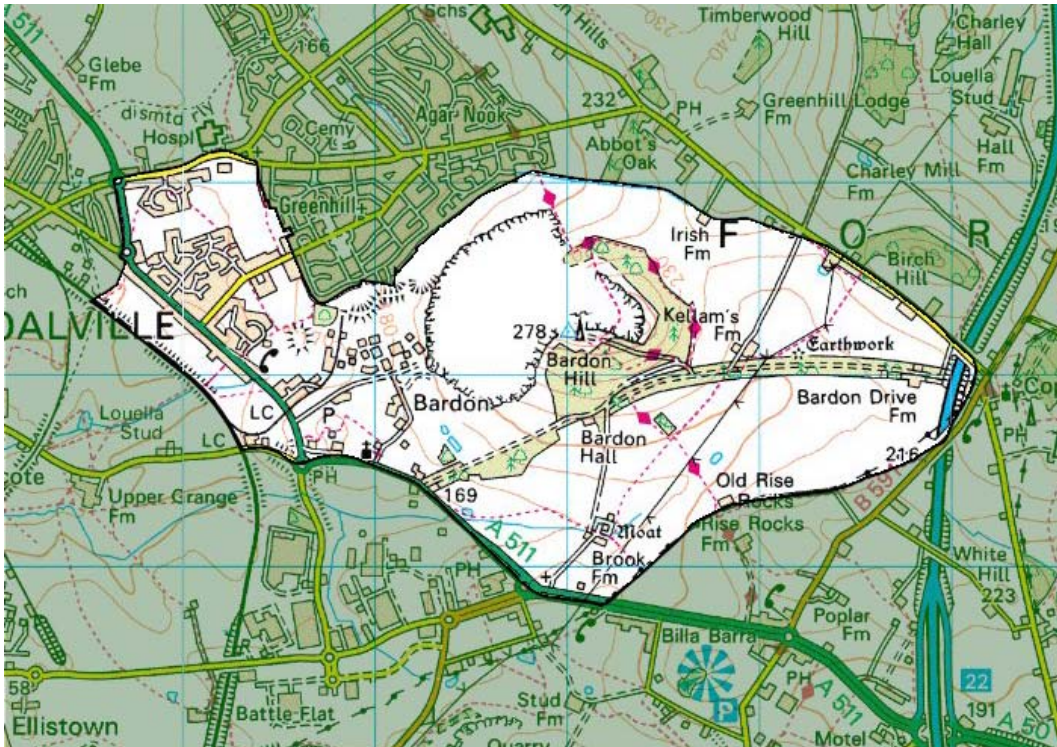

Bardon Ward makes up 2.6% of the population for North West Leicestershire.

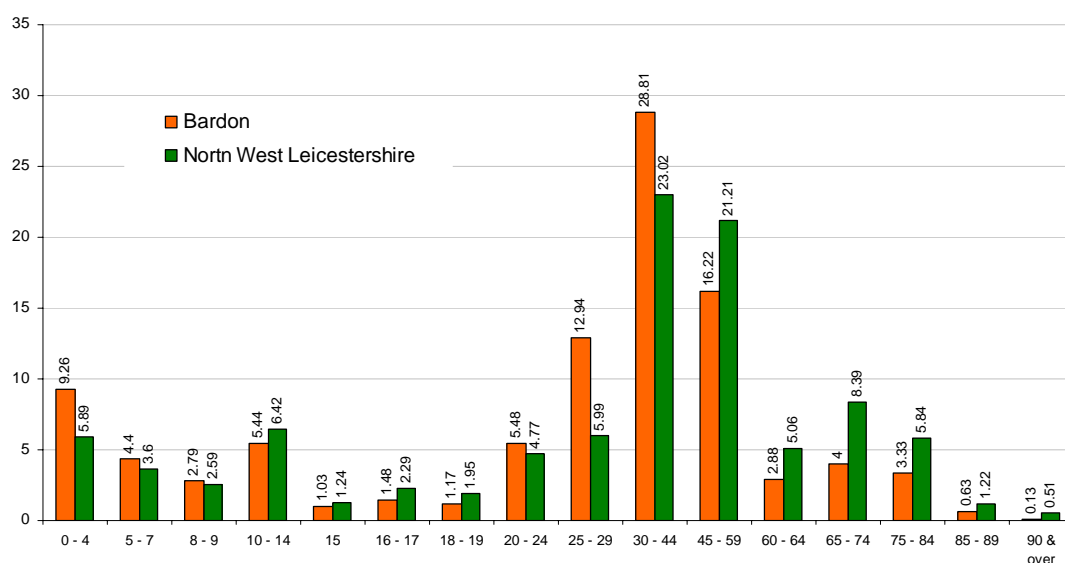

The graph below looks at the age structure as a % and compares Bardon with that of North West Leicestershire.

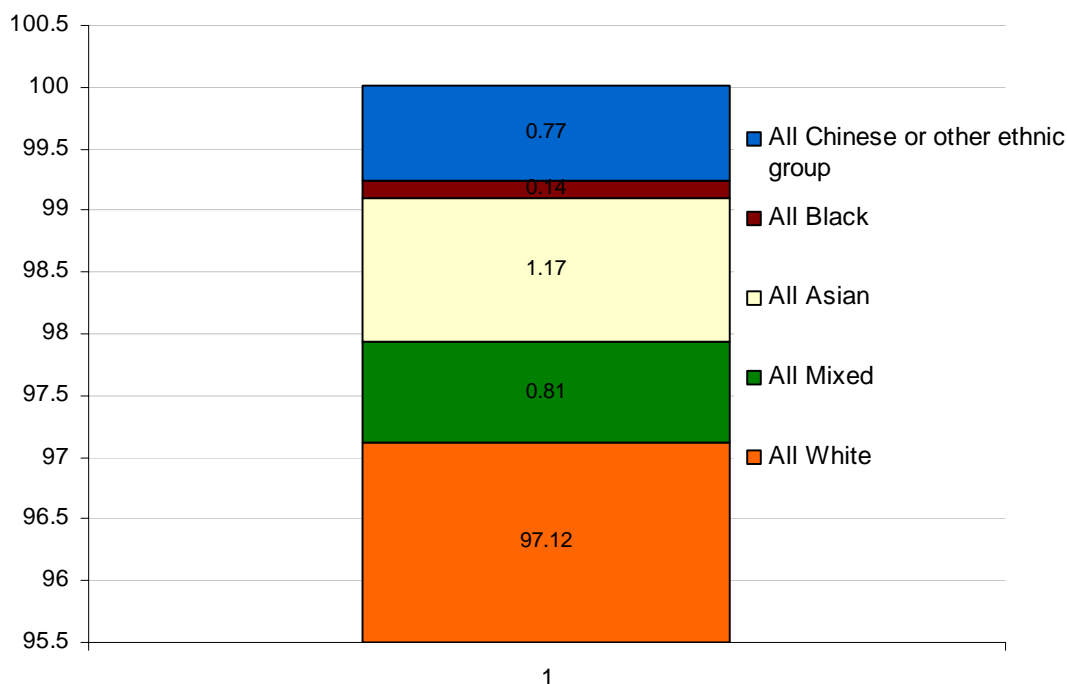


The graph shows which age groups are most predominant.

The table looks at what religion people in Bardon are, if at all. As with England, the highest percent of people are Christian – 75.79 %, with the next highest percent being people with no religion.

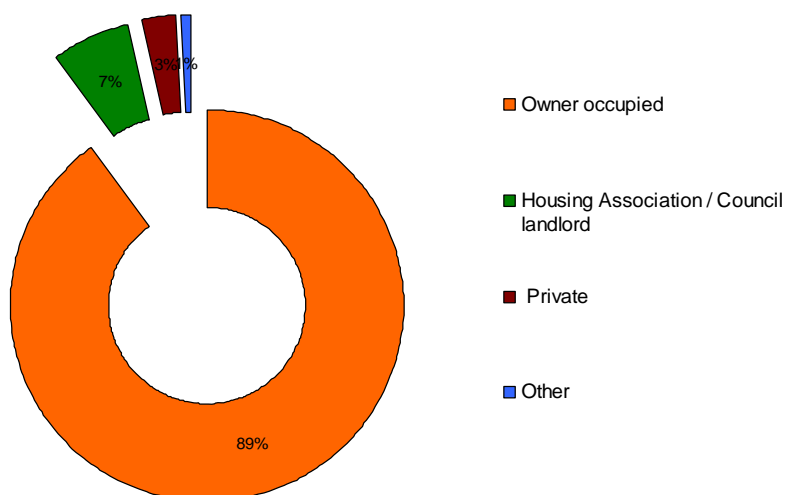

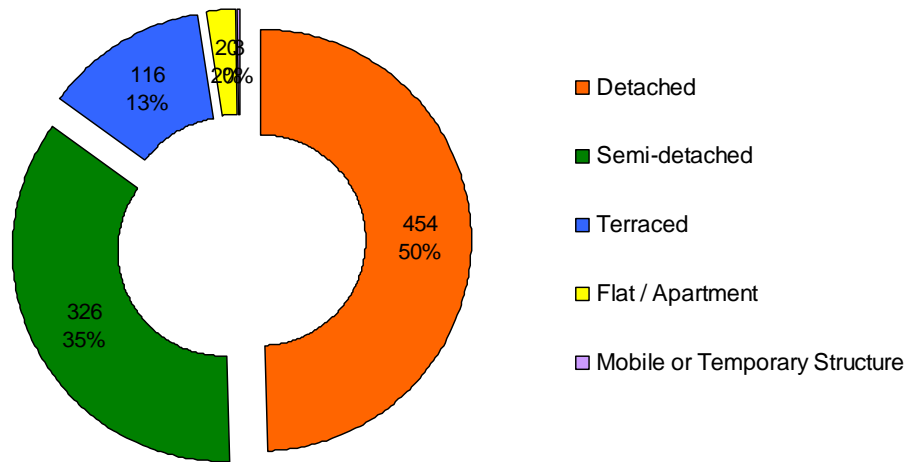

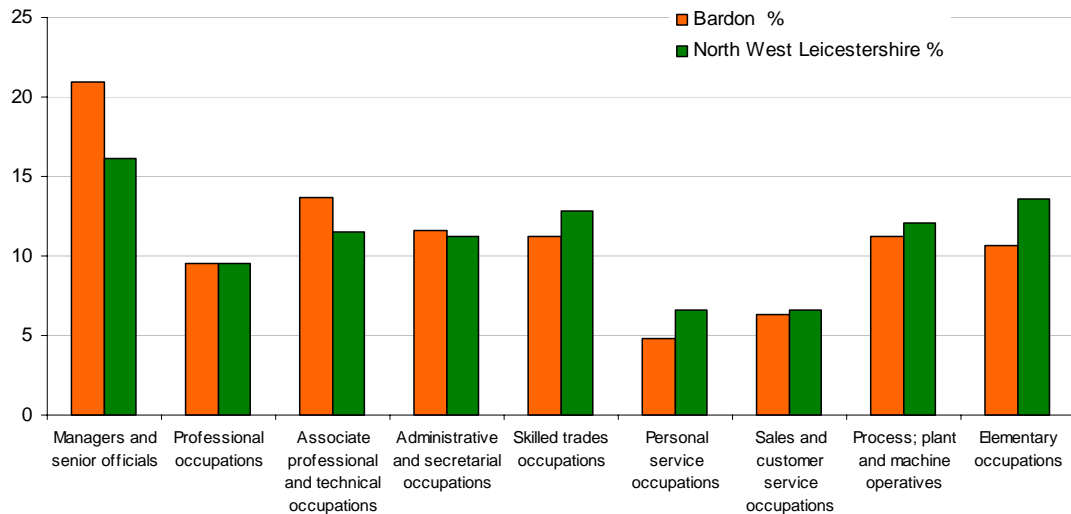
