What will happen when the Council has all the information?

The findings of the consultation on the proposal to create a parish council will be considered by a Working Group of Councillors who will formulate draft recommendations. Those of you who made representations during the initial consultation, will be consulted again on these draft recommendations and be invited to comment on them before they are formally considered.

Why is the Council carrying out this Review?

North West Leicestershire District Council has received a petition proposing the creation of a parish council in Hugglescote and Donington Le Heath. This means that the Council has to carry out a Community Governance Review which will consider whether the creation of a parish council is supported by local residents. The proposed boundary of the parish is shown overleaf.

What is a Parish Council?

Parish Councils are the most local level of elected local government which represent the interests of their community and are funded through an additional charge added to council tax bills [called a 'precept']

Many town and parish councils are involved in planning, promoting tourism, licensing, management of town and village centres and providing community halls.

Who is being consulted?

All local residents are being consulted on the proposal together with local businesses, local public and voluntary organisations, such as schools, health bodies and residents' groups.
