2. Nomination papers must be delivered at the **COUNCIL OFFICES, COALVILLE** on any day after the date of this notice, but not later than **NOON on Tuesday the 4th day of April 2011**.
3. Forms of nomination paper may be obtained from the undersigned at the Council Offices, Coalville or from the clerks of the parish councils. Either will, at the request of any local government elector for the said electoral area, prepare a nomination paper for signature.
4. If any of the elections are contested, the poll will take place on the **5th day of May 2011**.
5. Electors and their proxies should take note that changes to applications to be treated as a postal voter or proxy voter must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Coalville by **5.00pm on 14 April 2011**. Applications to be treated as a new postal voter for a particular election must be received by **5.00pm on 14 April 2011** if they are to be effective for this election. Applications to be treated as a new proxy voter for a particular election must be received by **5.00pm on 21 April 2011** if they are to be effective for this election.
