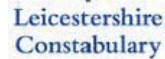


North West Leicestershire Partnership in Safer Communities

Our successes 2005- 2008

Underage drinking

In 2007 there have been a significant number of test purchasing operations targeted at reducing underage alcohol sales.

Drugs

We have continued to tackle drug dealers with particularly successful operations in 2007.

Anti-social behaviour

We have consistently targeted incidents of anti-social behaviour, and this has led to an improvement in people's perceptions over the last three years.

Respect

In March 2008, we launched the Respect Challenge which celebrated the work of nine locally funded projects, and the positive achievements of young people from the district.

CCTV

The systems in Coalville, Ashby and Agar Nook have been reviewed and improved to improve the safety of people who live, work and visit these areas

Domestic Violence

Loughborough Women's Aid have provided to a domestic violence outreach worker to help tackle abuse in the homes of our residents.

Our priorities 2008-2011

The Community Safety Strategy has identified five key priorities:

Reducing crime and the fear of crime

To work together in partnership to reduce the level and fear of crime by tackling key crimes across the district, focusing on particular geographic hotspots.

Reduce anti-social behaviour

To reduce the incidences of serious and persistent anti-social behaviour and alcohol fuelled violence by working in partnership with local people and agencies.

A safer evening and night-time economy

To work towards developing a vibrant and safe evening and night time economy within Coalville and Ashby town centres.

Tackling domestic abuse

To provide a robust intervention to tackle domestic abuse.

Focusing on issues affecting young people

To make children and young people a focus within each of the four priorities.
