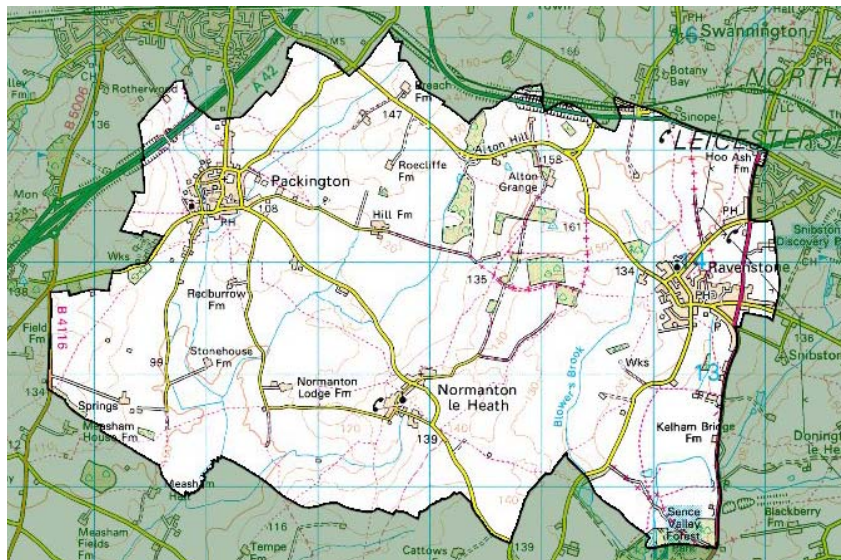

Ravenstone and Packington ward makes up 2.8% of the population for North West Leicestershire.

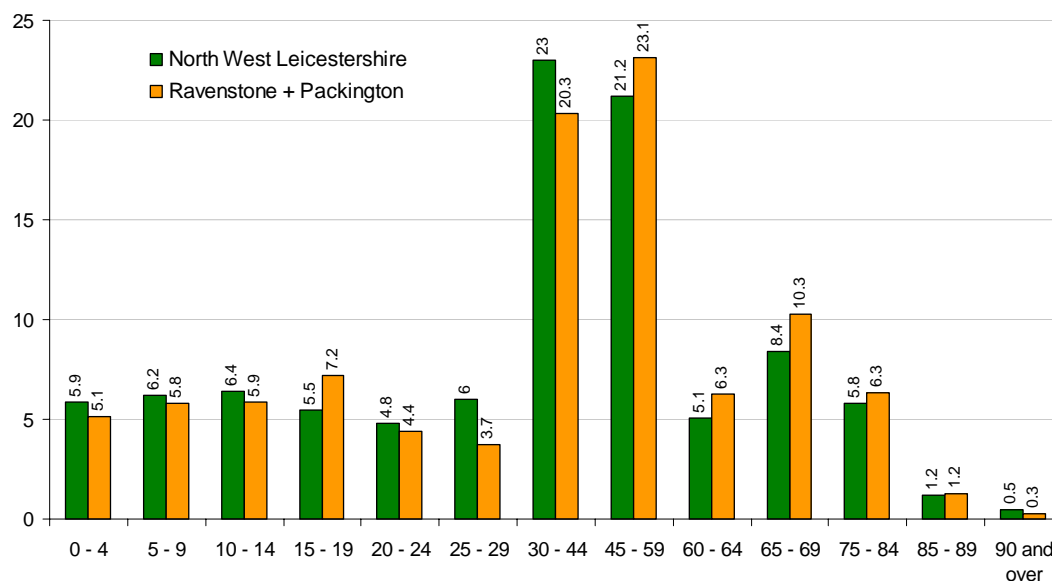

The graph below looks at the age structure as a % and compares Ravenstone and Packington with that of North West Leicestershire.

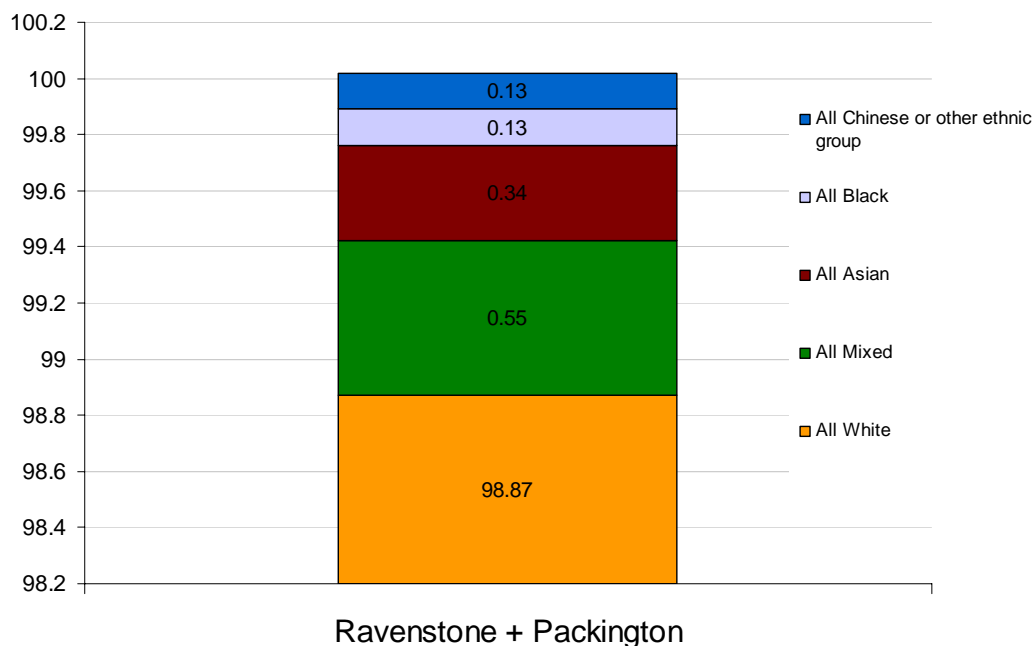


The graph shows which age groups are most predominant.

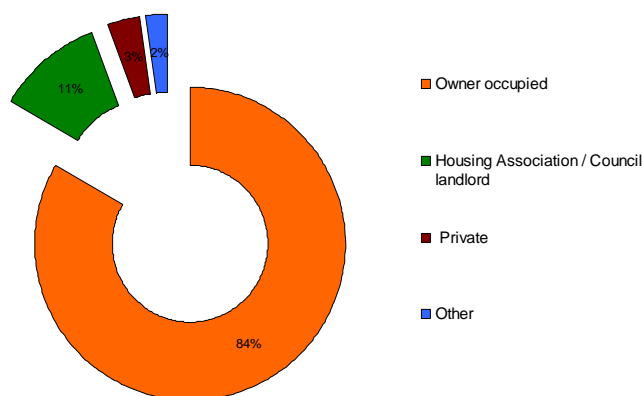

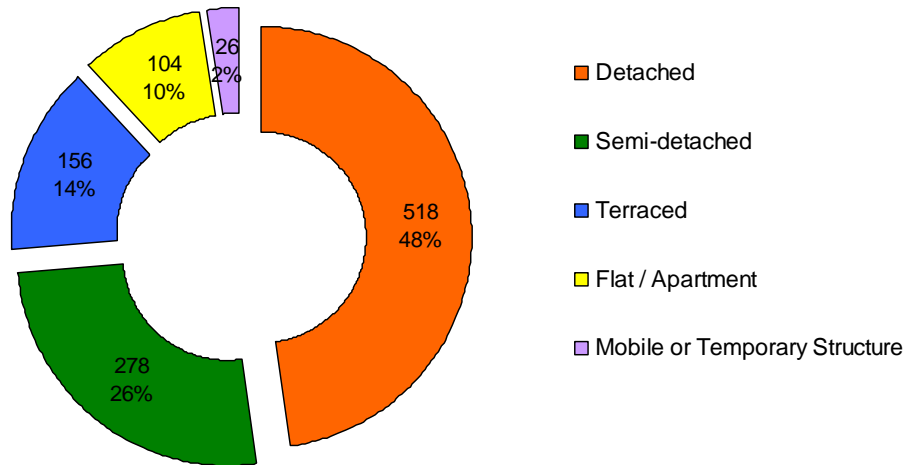

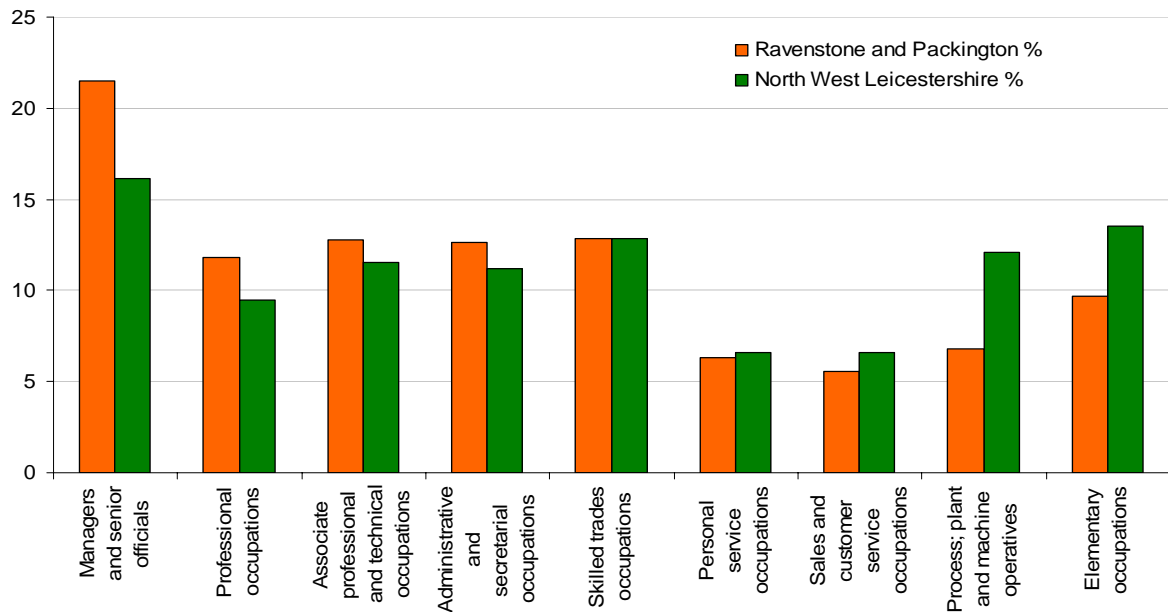
