

Statement of Community Involvement

ADOPTION STATEMENT

In accordance with Regulation 24 (4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 notice is given that on **3rd October 2006** North West Leicestershire District Council adopted the Statement of Community Involvement.

Any person aggrieved by the Council's decision to adopt the Statement of Community Involvement may apply to the High Court for consent to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any case no later than three months after the date of adoption detailed above.

Title of Document: Statement of Community Involvement (SCI).

Subject Matter: This Document outlines how North West Leicestershire District Council intends to involve the local community and key organisations in preparing the Local Development Framework (LDF) for the District. It also outlines the arrangements for consultation on applications for planning permission.
