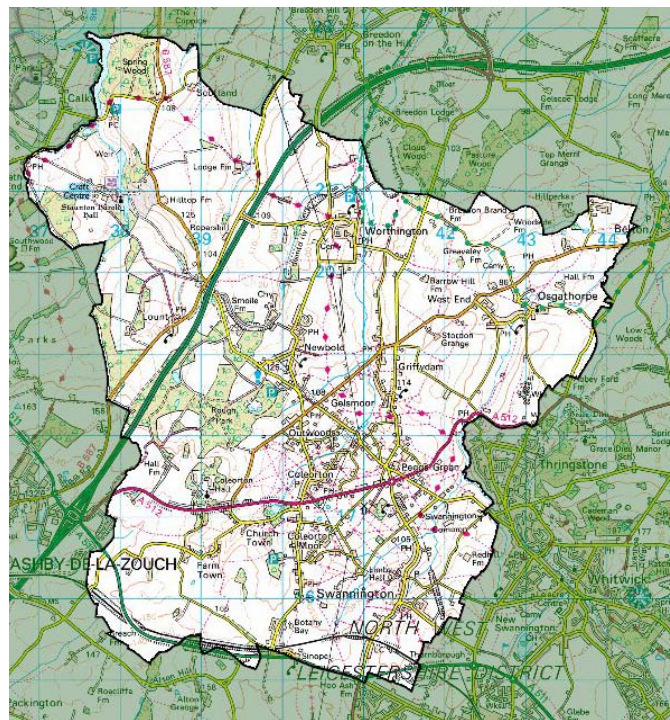

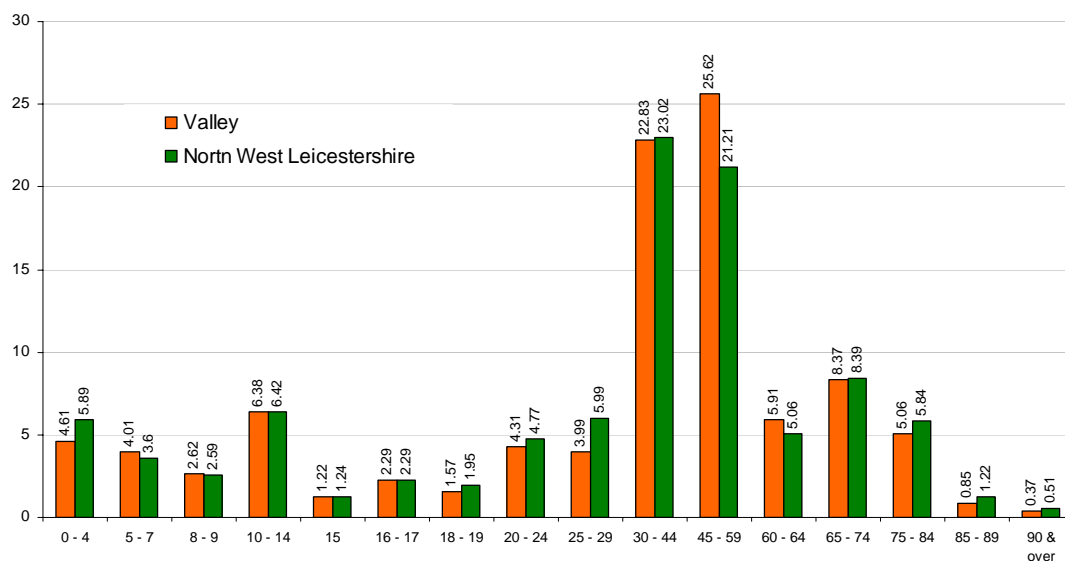

The graph below looks at the age structure as a % and compares Valley with that of North West Leicestershire.

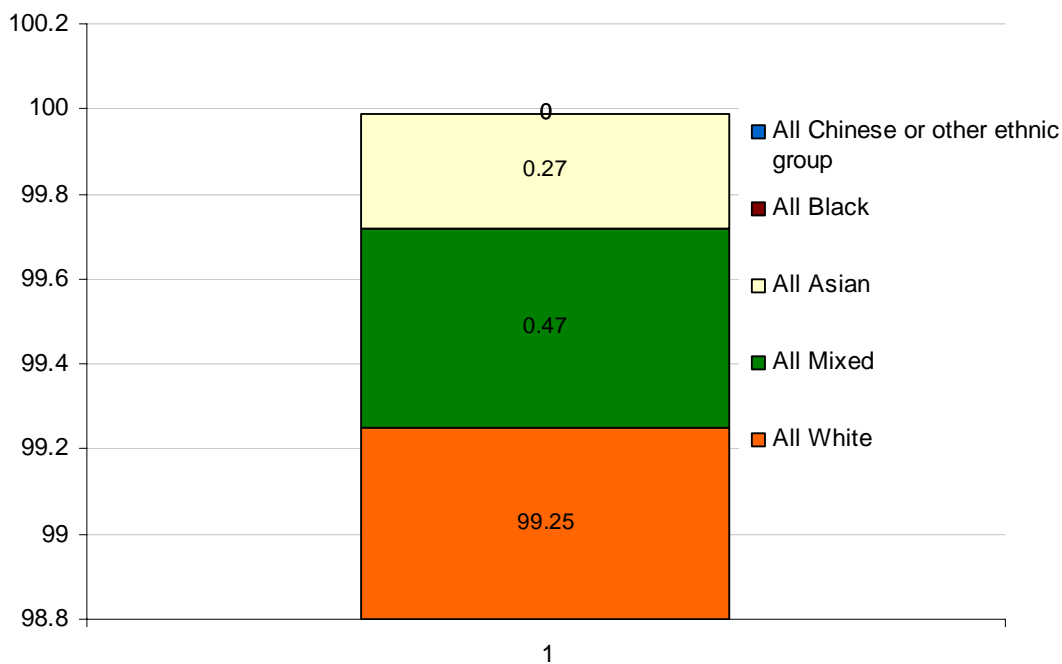


The graph shows which age groups are most predominant.

The table looks at what religion people in Valley are, if at all. As with England, the highest percent of people are Christian – 80.02%.

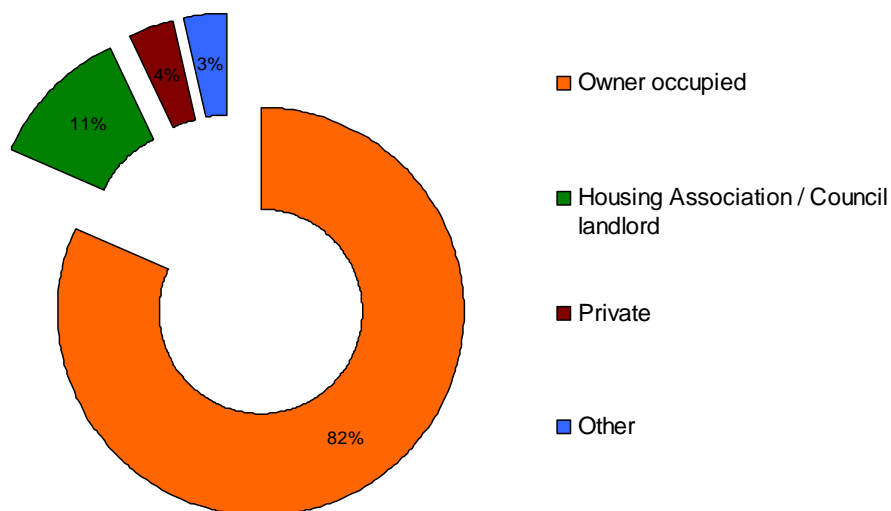

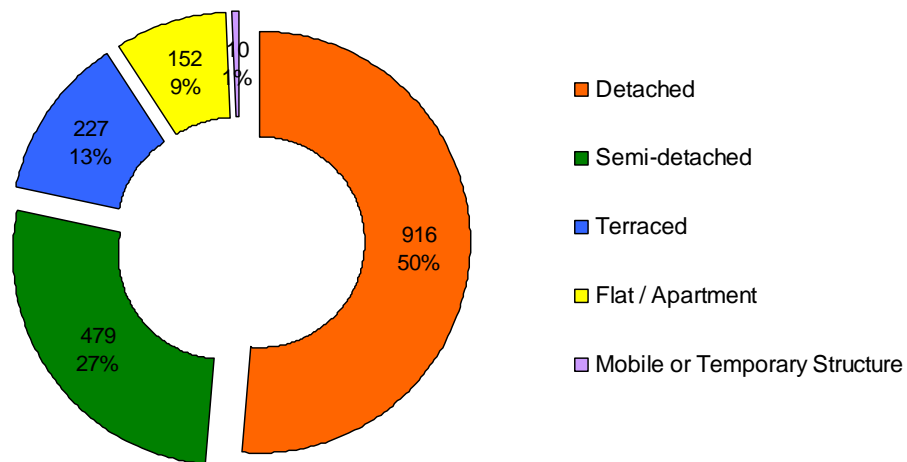

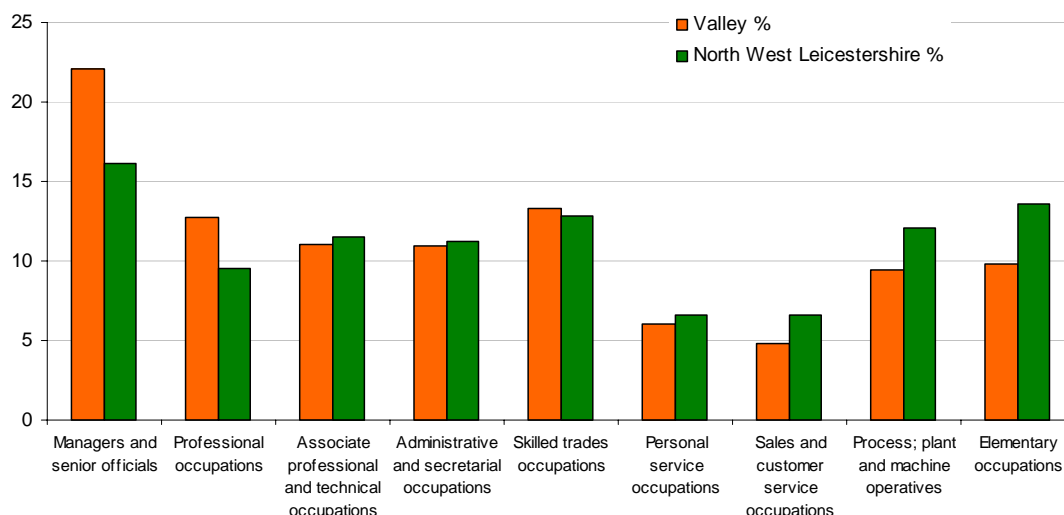
