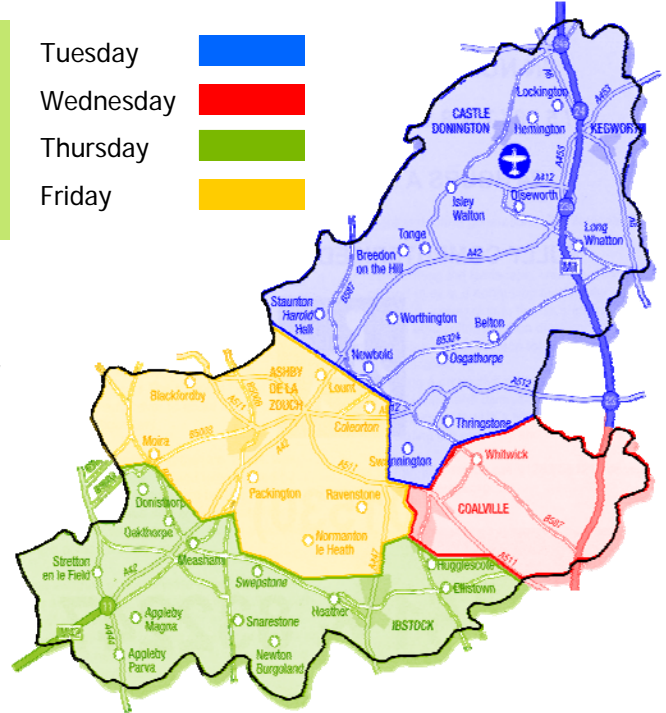
## Is your bin collection day changing?

### Why are collections going to be in Zones?

We have reorganised the rounds into zones to save money by being more efficient. The main benefits are:

- To save £100,000 to help meet our savings targets.
- To manage the effects of future housing growth on waste collection schedules.
- To save over 10,000 miles every year and reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 3,000 kgs.

### What important information do I need to know?

- Your collection day could be changing so you need to read, check, and follow the instruction on the calendar which will be delivered to you by the end of October.
- If you are due a recycling collection in the first week of November you should put out your red box, blue and yellow bags, and your black bin like you do at Christmas time.
- Please follow your new calendar so you are clear about what containers you need to put out for collection and when.



### Textiles Collections on the way!

From **1 NOVEMBER 2011** you will be able to recycle your unwanted clothes and shoes at the kerbside.

#### How will textiles be collected?

Your clothes and shoes will be collected on the same day as your red box and blue bag. Please put them in a carrier bag next to, or on top of your red box.
