We've been busy developing our journey to achieve zero carbon status by 2030. Here are some of the highlights from our third year....

Our electricity continues to come from a **renewable source**



Maintained **Green flag status** in Coalville Park and Broomleys Cemetery



Recycle rate of **46.6%** – the best in Leicestershire!



Upgraded all car park lighting to LED bulbs



Over **32,000** trees and hedging plants and **thousands** of spring bulbs given away



Signed Leicestershire Climate and Nature Pact



Installed four EV charging points in Measham to bring us up to **20 points across the district**



Saved **784 tonnes** of CO2 by switching fuel to HVO (hydro-treated vegetable oil) and received our first two electric vans



204 tonnes food waste collected – saving **153 tonnes** of CO2

Air quality monitoring continues

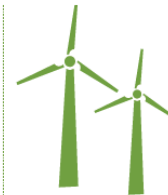


What plans do we have...?
