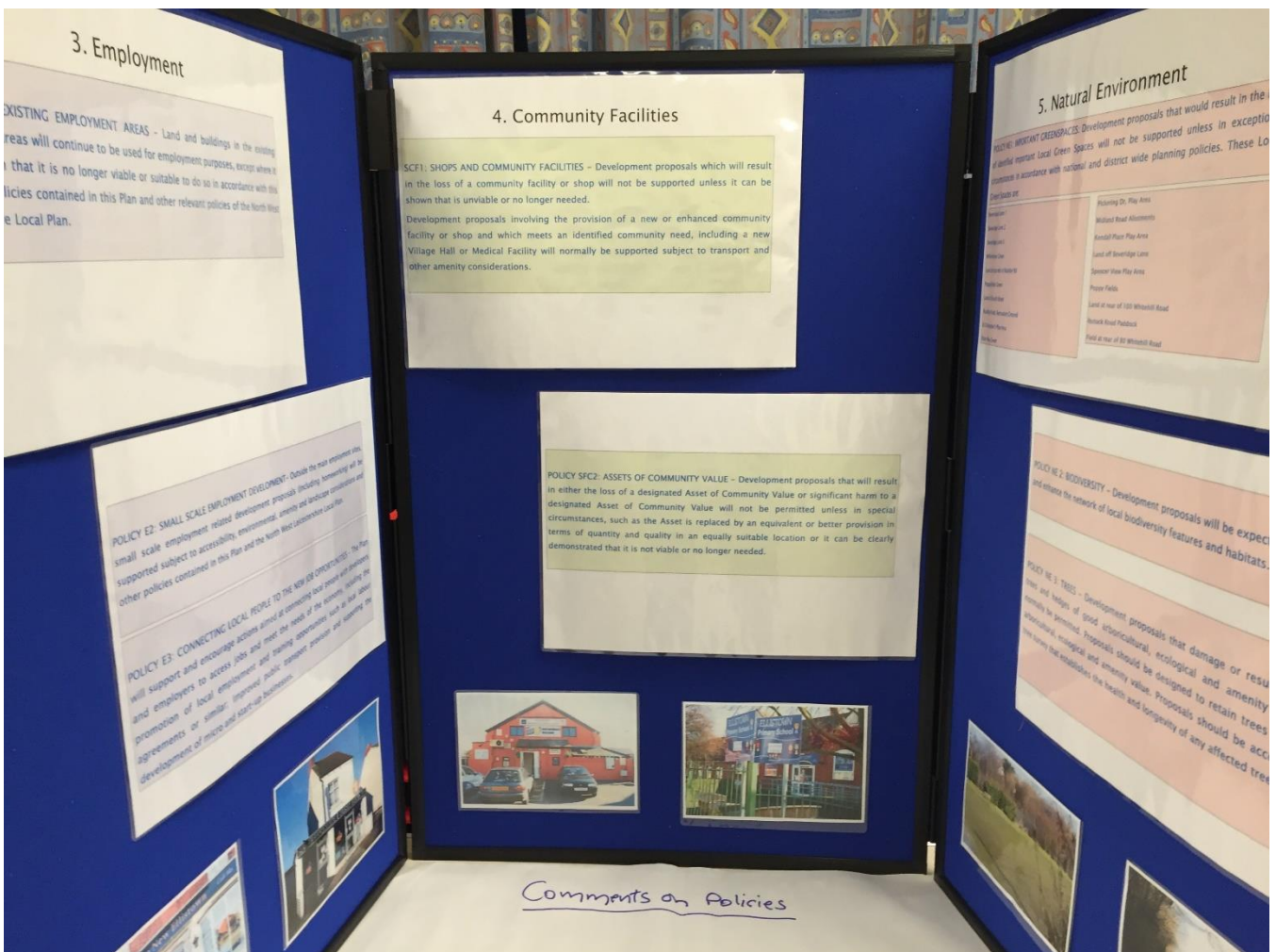

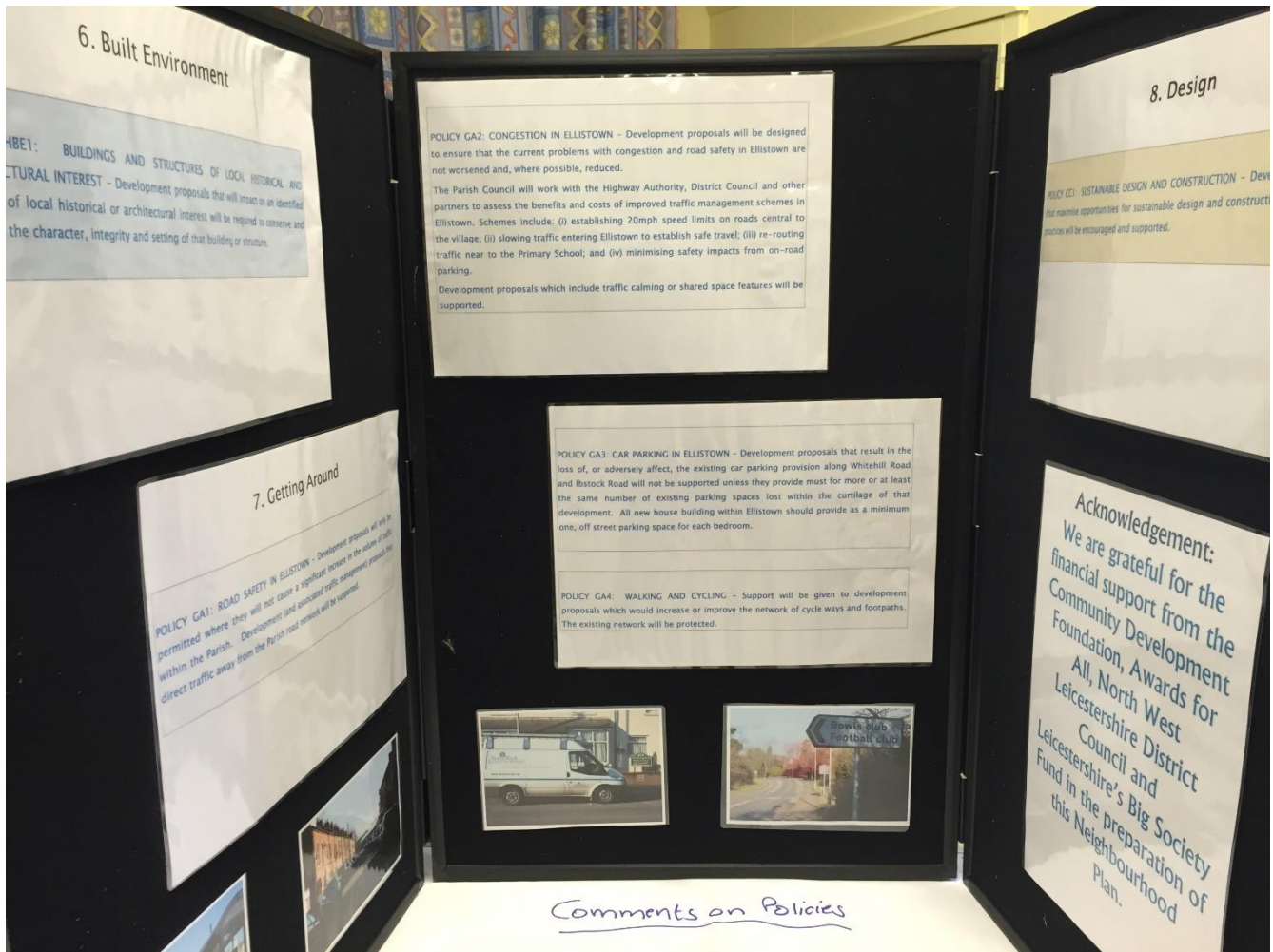

1. Introduction

A Neighbourhood Plan consultation event took place at the Ellistown Primary School on Sunday 8 November 2015 between 11:30 am and 1:00 pm. The event had been promoted through information placed on the Parish Council website and through an article in the local community newsletter. The event was timed to coincide with the Remembrance Day Service to maximise attendance.

The display boards prepared for this event identified the draft policies that were to be incorporated into the Neighbourhood Plan:





The policies that were presented had been produced as a result of the analysis of the community questionnaire, previous consultation events, deliberations of the Neighbourhood Plan Advisory Committee and evidence gathered from census data and other sources.

A small group of residents and stakeholders attended the meeting and engaged in discussion with members of the Advisory Committee about the emerging policies.

Those present were informed that the Neighbourhood Plan would be finalised on the basis of the comments received once the emerging Local Plan in preparation by North West Leicestershire District Council had taken shapeand that there would be a further opportunity for comment once the draft Plan had been written and approved by the Parish Council and submitted for pre-submission consultation.
