FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST 1093

I write further to your email dated 04 February 2020.

Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, explained on our [freedom of information](#) page.

Your request:

How many households of the council have been relocated outside of the council and where have they been relocated in the past ten years (from 2008/09 through the end of January 2020)

Please break these figures down into how many residents per household were relocated and where they were relocated to, per month.

If available, please answer how many residents were relocated from outside of the council to housing within your council in the past ten years (from 2008/09 through the end of January 2020)

You clarified:

- We're looking at all forms of households within the council boundaries that have been relocated- for any reason. This includes council housing, temporary housing, and private properties that the council have taken ownership of, for any reason.
- When I asked: "*How many households of the council have been relocated outside of the council and where have they been relocated in the past ten years (from 2008/09 through the end of January 2020)*," I am only interested in individuals and households who have been placed out of borough in temporary accommodation.

Our response:

Relocations booked through our system and one of our supported housing providers listed below. However, our second supported housing provider has not provided the information within your requests time frame and therefore not included in these figures. We do not hold details of numbers per household.

- *Year – Our data (relocation area), supported housing provider data (relocation area).*
- 2017 – 1 household (Derby), 4 households (Loughborough).
- 2018 – 21 households (Loughborough/Hinckley/Leicester), 7 households (Loughborough).
- 2019 – 29 households (Hinckley/Leicester/Loughborough), 7 households (Loughborough).
- 2020 (January only) – 8 Households (Hinckley/Leicester/Loughborough).

The supply of information in response to a freedom of information request does not confer the right to re-use the information. UK copyright law allows information supplied for the purposes of private study and non-commercial research to be used without permission. Information supplied can also be re-used for the purposes of news reporting except for in the case of photographs.
