I write further to your email dated 03 June 2020.

Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), explained on our [freedom of information](#) page.

Your request:

We are currently looking to benchmark our short-term sickness absence data for the year ending 31 March 2020 (2019/20) for the Waste Collection and Street Cleansing teams.

I would be grateful if your Council could share with us your year ending 2019/20 figure for the average number of short-term sickness days per FTE for manual workers within (i) Waste Collection and (ii) Street Cleansing/Street Scene teams along with the average number of FTE's for these teams too.

Our response:

Unfortunately our figures are only split at team level. Therefore the below figure include waste collection and street collection.

Average number of short-term sickness days per FTE is : 3.15
