FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST 1225

I write further to your email dated 13 July 2020.

Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), explained on our <u>freedom of information</u> page.

Your request:

 How many fire door replacement or maintenance works were <u>scheduled</u> to take place in Q1 and Q2 2020 across social housing properties in your local authority area; and how many properties were affected?

66 Fire doors were scheduled to be replaced in the 2020/21 financial year.

 How many fire door replacement or maintenance works <u>actually took place</u> in Q1 and Q2 2020 across social housing properties in your local authority area; and how many properties were affected?

No replacements have taken place yet.

- 3. How many fire door replacement or maintenance works to social housing properties in your local authority area that were scheduled to take place in Q1 and Q2 2020 were <u>delayed</u> <u>beyond their planned start date</u> for any reason; and how many properties were affected? 66 Fire doors have been delayed.
- 4. How many fire door inspections in social housing properties in your local authority area were <u>delayed</u> during Q1 and Q2 2020 for any reason; and how many properties were affected? No inspections have been delayed and no properties have been affected.
- 5. What plans are in place (as at date received) to commence delayed fire door installation, replacement or maintenance works to social housing properties in your local authority area before 31st December 2020?

Arrangements are to be made to remobilise the contractor to restart the works before then end of the year with a plan to be complete by the end of the financial year.
