FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST 1240

I write further to your email dated 01 August 2020.

Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), explained on our [freedom of information](#) page.

Your request:

1. The name and contact details of any organisation that you grant fund or commission in your locality to provide services and/or support (in some cases also known as social infrastructure support, capacity building or organisational development) to not for profit organisations in your area.
2. The name and contact details of any BAME organisations (those that are BAME led or working with predominately BAME communities and individuals) that you fund and details of the amount of funding provided to them.
3. The name and contact details of any disability organisations (those that are led by people with disabilities led or working predominantly with disabled persons and communities) that you fund and details of the amount of funding provided to them.
4. The name and contact details of any LGBT+ organisations (those that are LGBT+ led or working with LGBT communities) that you fund and details of the amount of funding provided to them.
5. The name and contact details of any womens organisations (those that are led by women or are working with women) that you fund and details of the amount of funding provided to them.
6. The name and contact details of any organisation that you fund to work with children and young people and details of the the funding provided to them.
7. Details of any additional and extra funding provided to any not for profit organisations in your area for organisation of, or being a part of an emergency response during COVID-19. The name of the organisation and the amount of money provided to them.

Our response:

Whilst North West Leicestershire District Council provides some grant funding to not-for-profit organisations (such as Citizens Advice, Age Concern, East Midlands Homes, Midlands Rural Housing,

The Bridge – a homelessness charity/project), none of them fit into the categories specified. As such North West Leicestershire District Council does not hold the requested information.

The supply of information in response to a freedom of information request does not confer the right to re-use the information. UK copyright law allows information supplied for the purposes of private study and non-commercial research to be used without permission. Information supplied can also be re-used for the purposes of news reporting except for in the case of photographs.
