FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST 1360

I write further to your email dated 06 November 2020.

Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA), explained on our <u>freedom of information</u> page.

Your request:

During the recent "Everyone In" scheme, local authorities in the UK were required to house rough sleepers through funding provided by central government during Coronavirus National Lockdown Restrictions (2020), I am enquiring about the months that followed as detailed below.

Please can you send me information for each of the following points?

- 1. How many rough sleepers in your local authority area were accommodated in total between August-October 2020?
 - 7 (3 originally accommodated prior to august).
- 2. How many rough sleepers in your local authority area accommodated under the "Everyone In" initiative in total between August-October 2020?
 - 1 (originally accommodated prior to august).
- How many rough sleepers in your local authority area, who were accommodated under the "Everyone In" scheme (March-July 2020) continued to be provided accommodation in the months August-October 2020? 1 (also included in 2 above).
- 4. How many of the rough sleepers accommodated at any time during this period (August-October) are considered to be No Recourse to Public Funds (NRPF)?

- How many of the rough sleepers accommodated at any time during this period (August-October) are EU nationals?
- 6. Have any rough sleepers placed in accommodation during this time been supported through a reconnection service to another part of the UK or to return to country of origin as well as information on the age, gender, nationality and marital status of those who have subsequently accessed a reconnection service.

The supply of information in response to a freedom of information request does not confer the right to re-use the information. UK copyright law allows information supplied for the purposes of private study and non-commercial research to be used without permission. Information supplied can also be re-used for the purposes of news reporting except for in the case of photographs.
