Work & Skills is a FREE service for anyone in Leicestershire. They can help you to find work or training opportunities no matter where you are in your career or employment journey.



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# The Leicestershire Adult Learning Service (GoLearn!) is offering FREE ESOL courses for Ukrainian refugees in Leicestershire.



ESOL courses are for anyone whose first language is not English, who needs to improve their skills for life, community, and work in the UK. You will practise speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in English. Daytime and evening courses are both available: daytime courses are twice a week (2 x 2hr sessions) and evening courses are once a week (1 x 2.5hr sessions).

We also offer specialist courses if you need to improve your English for work, or to improve your IT and maths skills. We also offer a specialist course to help you learn the English you need to pass your Driving Theory Test.

You will do an online assessment and a short telephone interview with one of our tutors before we match you to a class. You can do the assessment on a computer or laptop, or on a computer at a local library. If you do not have a computer or a laptop, or access to a library, you can do the assessment at one of our centres. This assessment will tell us your current level of English so we can match you to a class at the right level for you.

You can talk with a member of our team before we match you to a course and you can tell us if you have a preferred venue.

If you need help with the cost of travel to your venue, childcare during class time and resources, we can help. This can also include a laptop loan if needed.
