

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1980 SECTION 257

THE DISTRICT OF NORTH WEST LEICESTERSHIRE

**FOOTPATH N58 and N59 (Part), OFF GRANGE ROAD, HUGGLESCOTE
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2018**

This Order is made by North West Leicestershire District Council under Section 257 of the Town & Country Planning Act, because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, namely for use of land for residential development. (Planning permission number 18/00661/VCUM).

BY THIS ORDER

1. The footpaths over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the North West Leicestershire District Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the footpaths referred to in Article 1 above, as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
3. The diversion of the footpath referred to in Article 1 above shall take effect on the commencement date should North West Leicestershire District Council deem that terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
4. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule.
 - (a) Alternative Footpath N58 shall have a minimum clear width of 2.0 metres.
Alternative Footpath N59 shall have a minimum clear width of 3.0 metres.
 - (b) Fingerpost to be installed at all locations where the alternative routes for the Public Footpaths meet the vehicular Highway. The Fingerposts to be provided and installed by Leicestershire County Council, funded by the developer.
 - (c) Waymark posts to a specification shown in Standard Design Drawing SDFP6 to be installed at locations agreed with Leicestershire County Council along the along the alternative routes of the Public Footpaths
 - (d) Surfacing, to a specification agreed by Leicestershire County Council, to be constructed along the alternative routes of Public Footpaths N58 and N59
 - (d) This Order may be cited as the District of North West Leicestershire (Footpath N58 and N59, Off Grange Road, Hugglescote) Public Path Diversion Order 2018.
5. The Developer is hereby required to pay for the cost of carrying out the said works.

6. This Order may be cited as the District of North West Leicestershire (Footpath N58 and N59, Off Grange Road, Hugglescote) Public Path Diversion Order 2018.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAY

That Public Footpath N58 within the Parish of Hugglescote and Donington le Heath and the District of North West Leicestershire as shown by a bold black line on the plan annexed hereto which extends from the point marked A on the plan, situated at grid reference 44353 312493 in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approx. 310 metres to point B on the plan at Grid Reference 44374 31271.

The footpath to be diverted has a recorded width of 1.8 metres.

That part of Public Footpath N59 within the Parish of Hugglescote and Donington le Heath and the District of North West Leicestershire as shown by a bold black line on the plan annexed hereto which extends from the point marked C on the plan, situated at grid reference 44325 31262 in generally easterly and east north- easterly directions for a distance of approx. 500 metres to point B on the plan at Grid Reference 44374 31271 then in a generally north easterly direction for a distance of approx. 270 metres to point D on the plan at Grid Reference 44397 31287.

The footpath to be diverted has a recorded width of 1.8 metres.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF ALTERNATIVE HIGHWAYS

A Public Footpath, N58 within the Parish of Hugglescote and Donington le Heath and the District of North West Leicestershire as shown by a broken black dashed line on the plan annexed hereto which extends from the point marked A on the plan, previously described, in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approx. 220 metres to point F on the plan at Grid Reference 44355 31267; then continuing in generally east north-easterly and east south-easterly directions for a distance of approx. 90 metres to point G on the plan at Grid Reference 44366 31268; then continuing in generally northerly, north westerly, north easterly, north north-westerly, north easterly and northerly directions for a distance of approx. 60 metres to point H on the plan at Grid Reference 44367 31272.

The alternative footpath will have a width of 2 metres.

That part of Public Footpath N59 within the Parish of Hugglescote and Donington le Heath and the District of North West Leicestershire as shown by a broken black

dashed line on the plan annexed hereto which extends from the point marked C on the plan, previously described, in generally northerly, north easterly and easterly directions for a distance of approx. 120 metres to point I on the plan at Grid Reference 44334 31264; then continuing in a generally east north-easterly direction for a distance of approx. 165 metres to point J on the plan at Grid Reference 44349 31269; then continuing in generally north easterly and easterly directions for a distance of approx. 195 metres to point H on the plan at Grid Reference 44367 31272; then continuing in generally easterly, east south-easterly, east north-easterly, north north-westerly and north easterly directions for a distance of approx. 350 metres to point D on the plan at Grid Reference 44397 31287.

The alternative footpath will have a width of 3 metres.
