# Safer North West Partnership

- ▶ Created in 1998, (crime and disorder act 1998)
- ▶ Section 17 requires **responsible authorities** to consider crime and disorder and the misuse of drugs, alcohol and other substances in the exercise of all their duties, activities and decisions.
- ▶ **7 responsible authorities**
- ▶ Also works with commissioned services, 3<sup>rd</sup> sector or other groups
- ▶ Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner also involved
- ▶ Bi monthly Meeting, chaired by Cllr. Trevor Pendleton
- ▶ This meeting holds the partners to account and looks to the future.
- ▶ Performance and intelligence lead.

# The 3 year Strategy, 1 year action plans

- ▶ Must publish a 3 year Plan/Strategy
- ▶ New team, New approach
- ▶ The Community Safety Partnership (CSP) has set its 3 year plan, that has 5 themes
  - ▶ To make our community safer for residents, business and visitors
  - ▶ To support and protect all those who are vulnerable within our community
  - ▶ To work in partnership to achieve better value in what we deliver to residents, communities, business and visitors
  - ▶ Reducing reoffending
  - ▶ Substance misuse (such as drugs and alcohol)
- ▶ Themes are 'threaded' through every thing we do.
- ▶ No more annual refreshes, replaced with annual priorities.

# Priorities 2017-18

- ▶ We have set 3 priorities for this year
  1. Protecting those that live, work and visit the District from the effects of violence.
  2. Increasing community confidence by effectively addressing Anti-social behaviour and its causes.
  3. Support for business, schools and residents to reduce the risk of Cybercrime
- ▶ We are creating 3 action plans
- ▶ The PCC has funded these plans (£35,500) managed by the CSP
- ▶ The CSP will run the plans, holding us to account.

# Pulling it together-

- ▶ Community Safety Team will manage the plan, but we all deliver
- ▶ The individual organisations will have their own priorities to deliver as well
- ▶ Non priorities will still get a response where possible
- ▶ Our business plan, the crime plan, the police plan all have been considered when creating our approach
- ▶ PCC has been invited to be part of the process
- ▶ We are hoping that Parish Councils will want get to involved, including some great training opportunities, new skills and new theme champions (ASB champion and Cyber crime champions)
