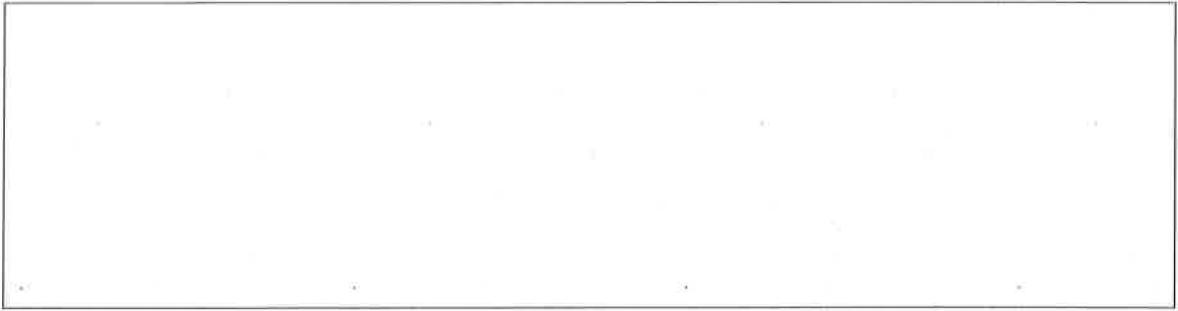

I object to the Local Plan on the following grounds:

- I do not agree that 3,200 new dwellings should be built in Ashby.
- I do not agree that a 65% increase to the size of our town, versus a 25% increase for the District as whole, is justified or sustainable.
- I believe that the infrastructure (transport, education, leisure, healthcare) proposed to support such growth is totally inadequate.
- I do not agree that the District needs an additional allocation of 1,750 new dwellings on Moneyhill.
- I believe that the proposed developments in Ashby are unsustainable and damaging to

the environment, particularly to the River Mease.

I am dismayed that the concerns of myself and many others expressed in the initial consultation exercise appear to have been ignored by NWLDC, but trust that the inspector will take account of them and carefully reconsider the proposed policies.

Nottingham Road is frequently congested, with narrow pavements outside the Upper School. Teenagers spill over into the road and there are also mothers with pushchairs and young children en route to junior schools. Accidents are only narrowly averted

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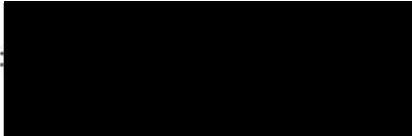

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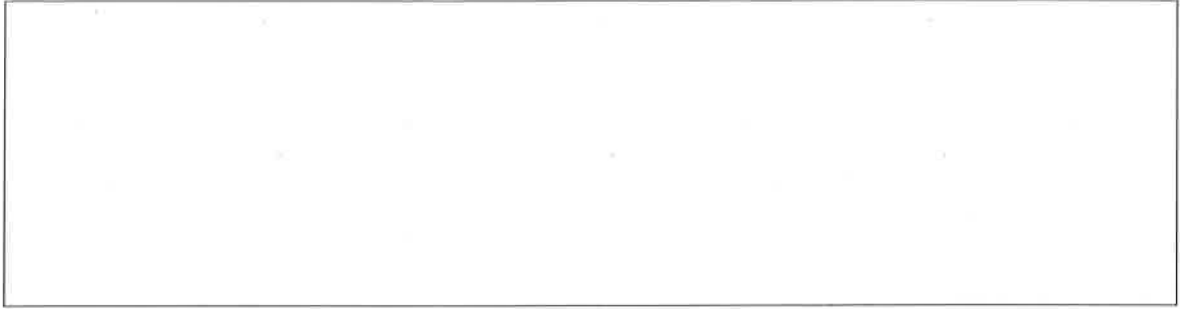
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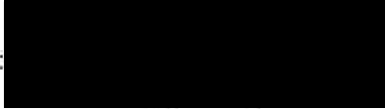
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
