

Vehicle testing and depot site rules

- The workshop and vehicle testing area is situated within a controlled site with restricted access and specific site safety rules. Upon arrival at the site, please use the intercom system mounted at the pedestrian access point to request authorisation to enter the site. When authorisation has been granted please proceed to enter the site in your vehicle via the indicated entry gates which will automatically open.
- Proceed directly to the designated parking bays which are situated in front of the office block and adjacent to the garage. Park within the marked bays and remain in your vehicle at all times. When the staff are ready to carry out the vehicle tests you will be instructed to move your vehicle to the entrance of the designated inspection testing bay. At this point you will be asked to open all windows of the vehicle and you will be directed to a designated viewing point within the workshop where you will remain at all times during the inspection until you receive further instruction.
- We will initially look at the cleanliness of the interior and exterior of the vehicle prior to test commencing. **If the vehicle has not been presented in a clean, valeted and sanitised manner the test will be refused and a recharge of £51.50 will be applicable.**
- **All personal items must be removed from all areas of the vehicle including any load space including where any spare wheel may be located. First aid kit, fire extinguisher and any tyre inflation kit (where no spare tyre is carried) must be left on display easily visible.**
- The approved Depot inspection staff will carry out the test on the vehicle. If any defects are identified, that require further clarification from the driver, this will be done whilst maintaining any Covid-19 Social distancing guidelines.
- Once the test has been completed, any paperwork will be left inside of the vehicle. Staff will be wearing PPE and disposable gloves which are changed for each test. The vehicle steering wheel driver's door handle, and instrument clusters will be wiped with sanitising wipes when the vehicle is handed back to you.
- Remember, if you are showing any signs or virus symptoms please contact us as soon as possible to rearrange any tests you have booked.
- Upon completion of your test and when instructed to leave the site please do so immediately via the one way system observing the **5 m.p.h** speed limit being aware of other site users. Please also note that due to changes with the depot weighbridge, there may be a delay with you exiting. Please be patient and only use the indicated exit gates to leave the site. **Please remember this is a busy site and all site rules and controls must be obeyed at all times.**
- At this present time, we are currently unable to offer DVSA MOT tests.
- Please note that there are currently no toilet or other rest facilities available onsite.
