
On two days in December / January we won't collect your garden waste. Instead, every household will receive three consecutive black bin collections during this period.



Please keep glass in a separate red box to mixed plastics, cans, tins and foil





Environmental Protection Act 1990 - Section 46 Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 - Public Space Protection Order
