


School Log Book

Evacuee Children


### World War 2

In September 1939 the school opened after the summer holidays and 8 children from evacuated areas of Birmingham were admitted. There were 2 classes, and a total of 46 children were on roll. Throughout the war time, the school continued to take evacuee children from Birmingham and in January 1941 there were a total of 4 classes and 79 children on Roll!

In September 1945, the school reopened after the summer holiday, but closed for a VE Day holiday.


